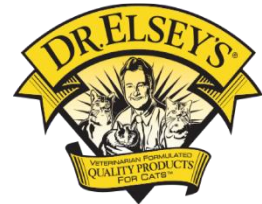

**COVID Status:** This show, as is any event, is subject to the regulations of the State of Washington. Masking is required. See summary for more information. These rules MAY change at any time. We will notify all exhibitors if there are new changes. For visitors from Canada or other countries, you may need to obtain a COVID test prior to coming as well as on return home. Rapid PCR tests are available (but a bit costly) at clinics in Seattle Airport. Portland Airport has clinics nearby. Check dates, times, and locations carefully. Sponsorship for COVID tests may be available - check with the Show Manager.

**Early Bird and International Rates** Early bird will be offered through December 25<sup>th</sup>. The International rate will be in place until regular closing.

### **Kitten and Cat Birthdates:**

All kittens entered for competition must be at least four (4) and less than eight (8) calendar months old on the day of the show (Sat show: born between May 21, 2021 and Sept 22, 2021; Sun show: born between May 22, 2021 and Sept 23, 2021.) Kittens may be spayed or neutered. Adult Alter and Championship Cats must be born on or before May 22, 2021 (Sat show) and on or before May 23, 2021 (Sun show).

**Juniors** We will have a junior program on Saturday during the lunch break. Official TBA. A junior discount is offered at the rate of one cat per junior exhibitor. Junior must be named on the summary sheet.

**Show Hours:** Saturday 10 AM to 5 PM

Sunday 9 AM to 4:30 PM

Seminars: The seminars will be held after judging on Saturday afternoon/evening. They may start earlier than 5 PM.

Anyone leaving before the scheduled times or before judging is completed must get show manager approval to retain any awards.

**Show Hall:** Our show hall is the Blue Pavilion at the S.W. Washington Fairgrounds. It is heated - but generally cool at this time of year. Wear layers and warm footwear and bring extra blankets for your cats.

**Hotels:** There is no official show hotel. Several in the area accept cats. Please check with the individual hotels.

**Recreational Vehicles:** RV hook-ups are available at the fairgrounds; RV's parked on the property must pay a fee. Service is a very basic 20 amp so you may need an adapter. If temperatures have been below freezing or are expected to drop, water may not be turned on.

**Supplies:** Litter will be provided but be sure to bring your own cat boxes and dishes. If you will need litter at a hotel, please let us know.

**Airports:** The closest airports are Seattle Tacoma International (SeaTac) (SEA) and Portland International (PDX). Both are approximately 2 hours away. Commercial shuttle service is available from SeaTac.

**Food:** We will have a coffee bar and will break for lunch to allow people to obtain food and beverages, but NO people or cat food will be available in the show hall. There are a number of restaurants and fast food places nearby and Wal-Mart is just across the freeway within minutes of the show hall.

**Clerks and Stewards:** Please indicate on the summary sheet if you are willing to clerk or steward. Assignments will be made once entries close, with compensation given at the end of the judging day.

**Benching:** Double cage size is 22 inches deep, 44 inches long, and 22 inches high. All wire cages must be covered on three sides, back and top. One adult cat or two kittens allowed per single cage space. This time of year, the showhall may be chilly; bring a blanket and/or adequate bedding for your cat to be comfortable.

All exhibitors will be assigned benching. Benching requests MUST be clearly indicated on the summary sheet and we will honor those requests as best we can. No benching positions can be changed without the permission of the show management.

**TICA Scoring:** This show is scored for TICA Regional and International Awards. Due to the pandemic, all shows at this time are considered to be under the Isolated Area rules for scoring and titles.

**Registrations:** All cats and kittens must be registered in order to qualify for regional and international awards. They will be allowed to be shown if the exhibitor demonstrates that they have applied for registration or that registration in TICA is possible.

**Health:** This is a Non-Vetted Show. All entries should be vaccinated against Feline Enteritis, Rhinotracheitis and Calicivirus and test negative for FeLV. Rabies vaccination is required in the State of Washington. It is advised that you bring your rabies vaccination records. Application of the law is subject to the enforcement by the reporting officer. All cats must have all claws, front and back back, clipped or they may be disqualified by the Judges. Adult household pets must be neutered or spayed. Any cats showing evidence of fleas, ear or fur mites, fungus or illness will be removed from the show hall. In case of disqualification by a veterinarian, the TICA rules require that all other entries owned or agented by the responsible exhibitor will forfeit their place in the show hall and must be removed as well.

**Show Rules and Liability:** This cat show is licensed, sanctioned, and scored by The International Cat Association. It is subject to their Bylaws, Show Rules and Breed Standards. Those are available from the TICA Executive Office at P.O. Box 2684, Harlingen, Texas 78551 as well as being posted on the TICA Website <http://www.tica.org>. By entering the show all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the Show Committee and the Judges. And A Mouse Cat Club, its members, TICA, the S.W. Washington Fair Grounds, its staff and representatives will be held harmless for any damages, claims, losses, etc. of/to any exhibitor and his/her entries.
